## SEALING OF IRON-DUST CORES AND TRIMMER'S

Note: This issue, Page 1, supersedes Page 1, of Issue 1, dated 3 Jul. 1945. It has been amended because of changes in designation.

- 1. Information (and subsequent action) for R.E.M.E. field and base workshop units.
- 2. To facilitate the adjustment of iron-dust cores and trimmers the following new materials have been provided:-
  - (a) Wax, sealing, iron-dust cores (Y3/YC 00600), to be used to seal iron-dust cores subsequent to their adjustment. This wax must be used sparingly.
  - (b) Compound, sealing, nitro-cellulose (WB 3621), to be used for the sealing of trimmers subsequent to their adjustment.
- 3. The A.Fs. G 1098 covering workshops which mormally include telecommunications le nts have been amended to include quantities of these materials. Further requirements may be met by demanding through the normal Ordnance channels.
